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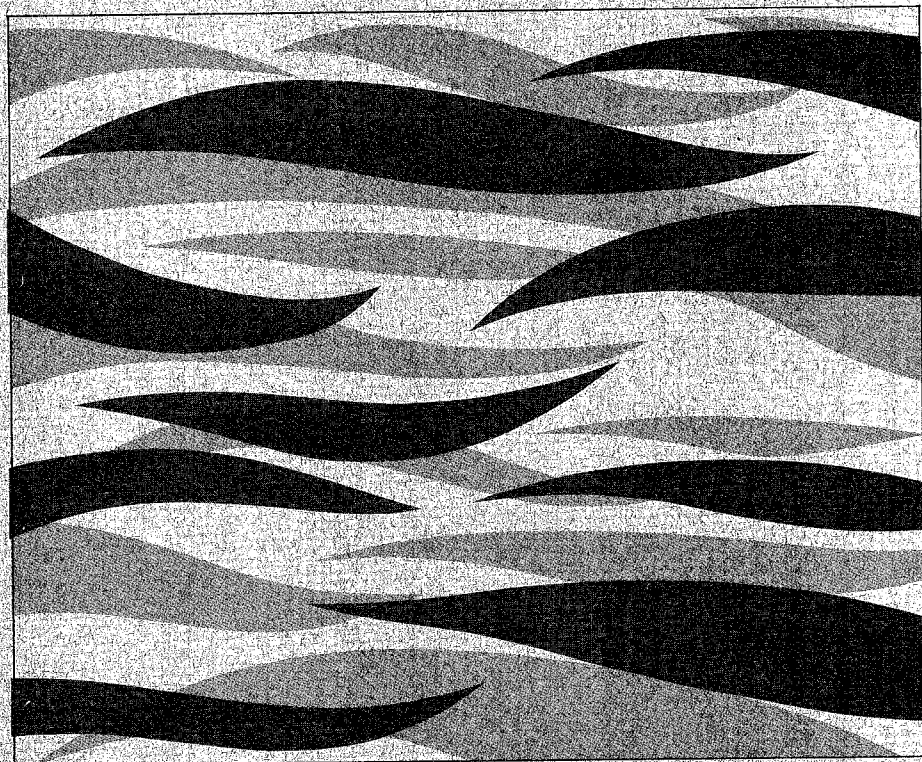

FOREWORD

The Institute of Water Resources has undertaken a number of activities, such as publishing research results, conducting seminars and special conferences, and encouraging staff members to participate in various organizations, to inform people in Connecticut of the problems, needs and activities in the broad field of water resources.

This volume, "A Bibliography of Publications Relating to Water Resources in Connecticut, 1900-1970," grew out of the realization that a great many articles about water were scattered over such a wide range of journals and professional reports that it was almost impossible to comprehend their scope, let alone know of their existence.

In the early stages of surveying the literature, it became apparent that the few articles published prior to 1900 would not justify the effort required to locate and verify them; hence, the decision to include in this publication only those of the present century, 1900 to 1970. It should be recognized that only articles about Connecticut water are included. It was beyond the scope of this volume to include all water articles published by people residing in the State but whose interests in water concerned some other geographic region.

For convenience in use, the publication is divided into two indices - one by subject and the other alphabetically by author. Agency names were used when an author was not given and, in a few cases, it was necessary to list the author as anonymous with the appropriate journal citation. In the Appendix are listed the addresses of all State and Federal agencies and private and public organizations concerned with water resources in Connecticut.

This publication should be of direct value not only to those attempting to learn about past activities in Connecticut on water, but also those who are planning future involvement with the use, management, and development of this important renewable natural resource.
