## HONORS AND PRIZES

**SENIOR HONORS:** A book prize established by the Faculty in recognition of those who have the highest standing in scholarship for four years.

ELIZABETH LIBBY KAMAROFF

**THE E. STEVENS HENRY SCHOLARSHIP:** Established by the bequest of the late Hon. E. Stevens Henry, for many years a trustee of the University. The income is awarded annually to the Sophomore who had the highest scholastic rank as a Freshman.

RAYMOND SAMUEL SCHULLEY, of the class of 1947

**THE BORDEN AGRICULTURAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD:** A cash award to the Senior in the College of Agriculture who has the highest average grade of all similarly eligible students in the first three years of work and who has taken two or more dairy courses.

ROBERT BARNES BLACKMAN, of the class of 1945

**THE WILLIAM DURAN HOLMAN PRIZE IN ANIMAL HUSBANDRY:** Founded by bequest in memory of William Duran Holman, for many years treasurer of the University. Income awarded annually to the Senior and the Junior having the highest standing in Animal Husbandry. This year no award is made to a Senior.

NATHAN STRONG HALE, of the class of 1946

**THE RATCLIFFE HICKS PRIZES IN ENGLISH COMPOSITION:** Founded by the late Ratcliffe Hicks of Tolland, to be awarded annually for excellence in English composition as displayed in original essays. The contest this year was judged by Professor Alexander Cowie, Wesleyan University.

**THE FANNIE HATHEWAY BOSS PRIZE:** Established by gift of Mrs. Fannie Hatheway Boss of Willimantic, to be awarded annually for excellence in French.

**THE LEHN AND FINK MEDAL:** A gold medal, properly inscribed, awarded each year to the member of the graduating class in the College of Pharmacy who has the highest general average for the four years.

**THE GARVIN MEMORIAL PRIZE:** A cash prize given by the Connecticut Pharmaceutical Association, and awarded to the member of the graduating class in the College of Pharmacy who has shown the greatest progress since his freshman year.

**THE PHARMACY COMMISSION PRIZE:** A cash prize given by the State Pharmacy Commission and awarded to a member of the graduating class in the College of Pharmacy for excellence in Practical Pharmacy.

**THE BIOCHEMISTRY PRIZE:** A cash prize given by a pharmacist of New Haven and awarded for excellence in Biochemistry.

**MERCK PRIZES:** Two sets of three books each given by Merck and Company and awarded to students who stand high in Pharmaceutical Chemistry and in Pharmacology.
