CHARLES LANMAN HUBBARD, of the class of 1945

THE RATCLIFFE HICKS PRIZES IN ENGLISH COMPOSITION: Founded by the late Ratcliffe Hicks of Tolland, to be awarded annually for excellence in English composition as displayed in original essays. The contest this year was judged by Professor Edward A. Post of Boston University.
