Also present, Trustees; Jenkins, Pierpont, Patten, Capen, Hopson, Manchester, and Alsop, also President Beach, of the college.

The record of the last meeting was approved without reading, each member having received a copy thereof.

Voted; That His Excellency, be directed to take steps to secure the prosecution of Mr Edgar Rhoades, for presenting a fraudulent bill against the college.

Voted; That from and after the beginning of the next college year, a charge for Laboratory expenses shall be made to each student.

No further business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
